

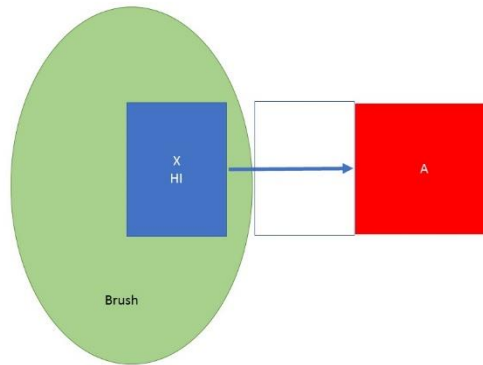
Exceptions to an Uncontrolled Charge.

Clarification : 2.f

- *Uncontrolled charge : page 41*

Problem:

The rules stipulate (page 41, point 10) that an impetuous unit is not required to make an uncontrolled charge “If the charge would cause the unit to enter terrain that inflicts a combat penalty on it”. This text leads to interpretations as to whether or not this exception applies when a unit begins its charge in a penalizing terrain but ends it in clear terrain (see example below).



Situation: A Blue impetuous HI unit is in brush terrain. By charging straight ahead it can contact the Red MI unit X and fight in clear terrain.

Question :

- In the above case, is the impetuous unit subject to an uncontrolled charge ?

Answer:

- **Yes**, because the charge ends in terrain that does not inflict a combat penalty.
- Point 10 on page 41 should therefore read as follows:
 - **“if, as the result of the charge move, the unit ends up in terrain that would inflict a combat penalty on it”**
- **Note:** The situation in which an impetuous unit would have to cross a river to reach a target on clear terrain is also another exception to the uncontrolled charge requirement covered by point 4 on page 41.
